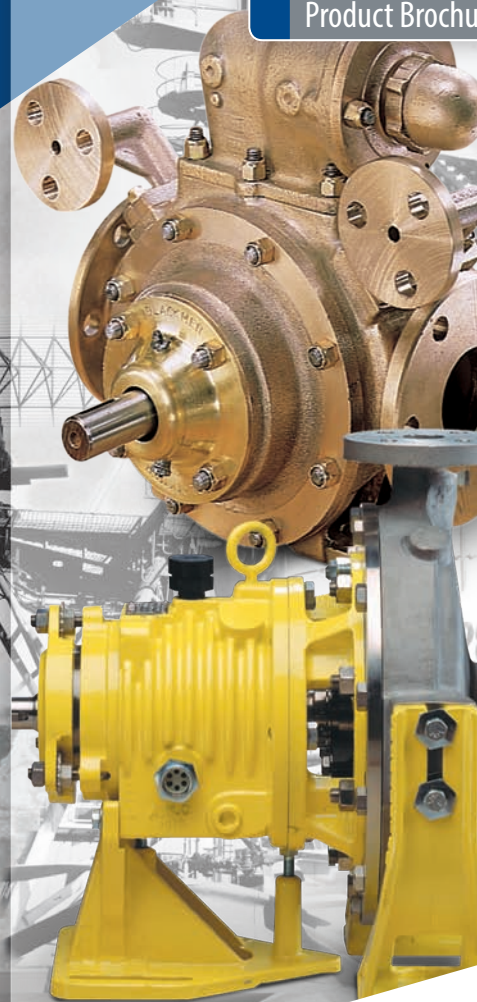

Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul

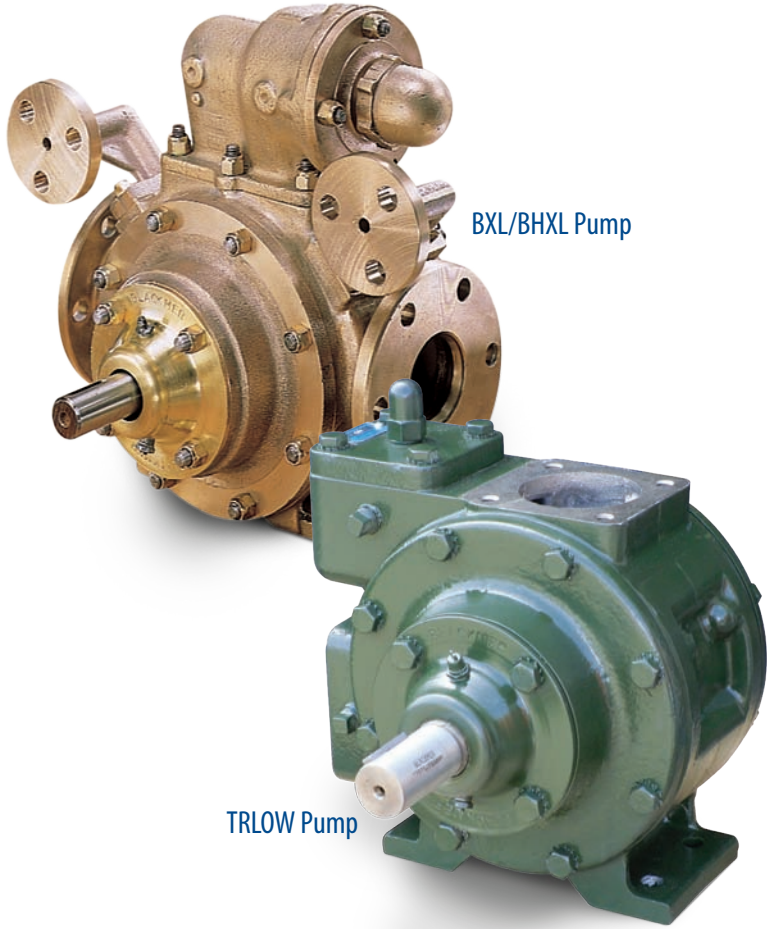

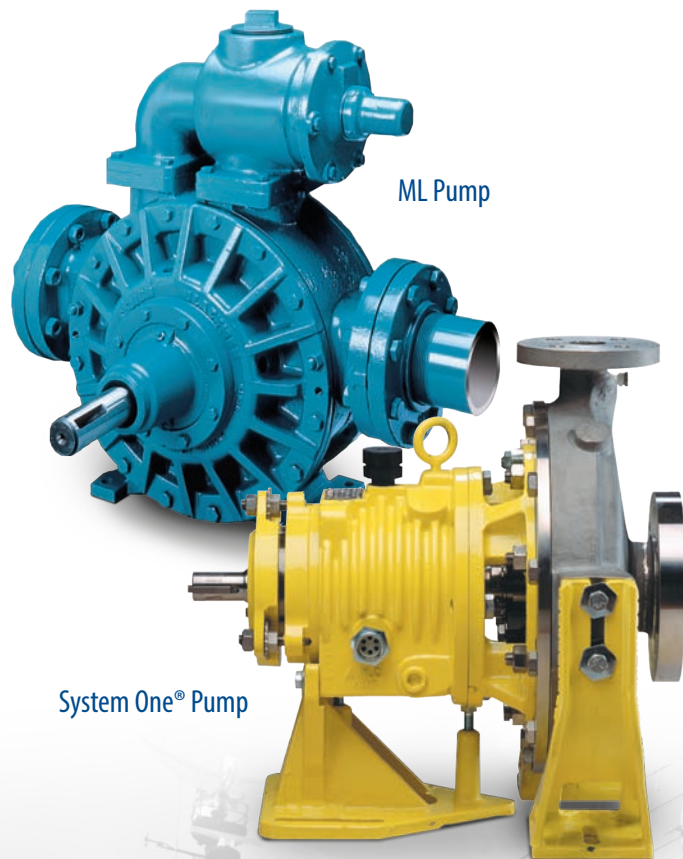

Making Repairs an Easy Process

Blackmer's Repair Facilities make it easy to get your pump back online quickly. It starts with an agreement that specifies which branch of the U.S. Military will send its pumping units (including gearbox and motor) to a Blackmer facility whenever repairs or reconditioning are required. After that, it's a simple process:

- Items are sent to the repair facility for inspection
- A quotation specifying the cost of repairs is submitted to the military base or naval vessel
- In reviewing the quotation, the base determines whether the pump should be repaired or scrapped
- If repairs are requested (which is the case 99% of the time), facility personnel perform repairs
- Pump is returned to military base or naval vessel
- Pump is either re-installed or stored on-site until needed

The repair facilities also have Department of Defense clearance to perform repairs or overhauls on-site, if requested, though the majority of repair work is done at the repair facility.

One-Year Warranty on Parts and Labor

Doing the job right the first time is our main goal. This allows the military branches to concentrate on their larger mission: protecting and defending the country. Don't trust pump repairs to somebody who isn't familiar with Blackmer products or who may not understand the unique needs of the military market. Trust the professionals at Blackmer's Military Repair Centers. Blackmer is so confident in the performance of its military-repair personnel that it offers a **one-year warranty** on all parts and labor.

Use Factory Certified Parts

It is imperative to preserve the safety of the base, its personnel and its vessels. Using non-factory parts is not only illegal, but it poses a dangerous risk to critical pumping components. Blackmer repair facilities use only Blackmer parts that are certified to withstand the shock and vibration that is required of military duty operations.
